At the corner of Rue Rogue and Rue Noé, look up and you will see two jovial figures greeting you. Carved in stone, they represent the master and mistress of this 16th century house. Their history is still a mystery. However, they have now become the mascots of the people of Vannes.

AFTERNOON

Walk in Conleau


If Conleau is one of the districts of Vannes which was built during the 20th century from two former hamlets, it is also a peninsula located 5km from the city centre! You will find a seawater swimming pool, ideal for refreshing yourself on a sunny day.

Crossing to Séné

Take the ferry (5 minute crossing) from Conleau to discover the town of Séné

The Gulf of Morbihan is 12,000 hectares of Atlantic sheltered from the swell in Southern Brittany, it is a real little inland sea!


DAY 2

ENTIRE DAY

Excursion to Île-aux-moines

Only 5 minutes by boat from Baden, discover the small island of Ile-aux-moines. The tour of the island is 17 kilometres long and takes about 4 hours and 15 minutes to complete. On the Île-aux-Moines, cycling and walking are king.

Take advantage of this unique opportunity to discover the island's heritage and its remarkable views over the Gulf of Morbihan.
